

What is radon?


Did you know there could be a silent intruder lurking in your home? Meet radon—a colourless, odourless radioactive gas naturally occurring in many rocks and soils. It can accumulate in indoor spaces, particularly in basements and properties built into hillsides. While radon is a harmless natural occurrence in small amounts, prolonged exposure can be dangerous. It is the second-largest cause of lung cancer in the UK.


Is your property at risk?

If you own a property in Cornwall, it's time to take action. Almost every property in the county is considered part of a Radon Affected Zone, with only a few localised regions like The Lizard and the extreme northeast being exceptions.

The only way to determine if a building has high radon levels is to have it tested. Don't wait for warning signs; take proactive steps to protect your health.
