

# Longrock Coastal Protection Newsletter - April 2019

## Rock armour works commencing on Longrock Beach.

### Site Set Up

Our site compound set up began on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2019. Longrock Car Park is closed to the public from 4<sup>th</sup> March 2019 until the end of July 2019. A diversion to the Public Right of Way (PRoW) will also be in effect for this duration. The closure of the car park and PRoW diversion is necessary to minimise disruption by reducing the need for additional traffic movements for transporting materials and equipment.

The Mean High Springs Water (MHSW) line is demarcated by scaffold tubes and cones. This non-physical barrier for our works site

has been selected as barrier mesh was considered to be an environmental hazard in this coastal location.

### On Site Progress

Digging of archaeological trial pits took place on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2019 to investigate the possible presence of tank traps. No archaeological features were found.

Rock armour deliveries began on 20<sup>th</sup> March 2019. Rock armour installation has started at the western end (Penzance end) where the new rock armour will tie into the existing.

### Forthcoming Works

Rock armour installation will continue working in a west to east direction which will entail beach excavations and ongoing rock armour stone deliveries.
