Open water channels on Marazion Marsh complete. Weir works to commence in January 2020.

On Site Progress

The amphibious excavator was mobilised on the marsh on 29th October 2019. The open water channels were completed on 11th December 2019 and the amphibious excavator was removed from the marsh on 12th December 2019

Forthcoming Works

Installation of the new, fabricated weir wall will commence from the second week of January 2020. The installation of the automated penstock will follow on from this.

There will be trenching works to and adjacent to the highway to facilitate cabling and ducting for the automated penstock, so the necessary traffic management measures will be in place during these times.

Public Information

The steps and a platform on the marsh embankment will be modified to provide site access to the weir. **These are for construction access only and are not for public use.**
