New weir & penstock works at Marazion Marsh completed

Completed Works

In December 2019, the Open Water Channel Works at Marazion Marsh were completed. This reed clearance and formation of deep-water channels will:

1. Increase the wetland habitat for birds, fish, eels and other wildlife
2. Improve the quality of habitat via clear water channels.

The works to construct and commission a penstock fixed to a prefabricated weir wall were completed at the end of June 2020. The works also included the installation of a new trash screen.

The penstock allows for water levels to be remotely controlled and will prevent flooding by increasing water storage when required and will also allow levels to be controlled to provide optimum conditions for nesting birds.
